A Level / BTEC results:

BISC students achieved a 100% A* - E pass rate in all their subjects. This means everyone has gained places at their 1st choice universities in the UK, Canada, USA, UEA and Spain, reading a wide and diverse range of subjects including PPE, Business, Economics and Languages.

iGCSE results:

BISC students achieved a 100% pass rate in all subjects taken, which is extremely impressive in itself. However, this headline figure is not truly representative of the incredible performance by our students, which also includes:

- 62% of all papers taken achieved A* A grades.
- 80% of all papers taken achieved A* B grades.
- STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) 100% A* B pass rate in Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science and Physics.

I cannot begin to emphasise how truly outstanding these results are, and I know of certain independent schools in The UK will be extremely envious of these results! Given that English is the 3rd language for most of our students, the performance of our students is nothing less than extraordinary.
