<u>Aims</u>

To ensure that we keep children safe in education at all times, it is important that everyone has a full understanding of the expectations of the school in terms of how students are dropped off in the morning for school and then picked up in the afternoon.

Due to the confined parking by the front/side of the school, parents and students are asked to follow the following protocols.

Secondary School: Years 7 – 13

Students in the Secondary have their own access point/gate at the side of Block B. This is staffed during the morning and then in the afternoon. The Head of Secondary will be at this location in the morning.

Parents who have children in the Secondary school are asked to either:

- Drop your child at the front car park and let them walk up.
- Drop your child at the gate by Block B.

Parents should not drop their child outside the front of Block A (The Primary School) as this location is always congested.

Primary School

Students in the Primary School have their own access point/gate at the side of Block A. This is staffed during the morning and then in the afternoon. The Head of Primary will be at this location in the morning.

Parents who have children in the Primary school are asked to either:

- Drop your child at the front car park and escort them to the gate.
- Drop your child at the gate by Block A where a member of the site staff will help

<u>EYFS</u>

EYFS students must be dropped off at the EYFS gate and escorted in. They are not to use the gate to Block A.

For morning drop off - at the EYFS gate from 07.30 onwards there will be 2 TA's to welcome parents and students. Parents must escort their child to the gate.

For afternoon pick-up – at the EYFS gate there will be 1 teacher and 2 TA's to ensure students are safely released back to their parents. Parents must collect their child from the gate.

<u>Under NO circumstances at ANY time should a child in EYFS/Reception be dropped off in the front car park and be allowed to walk up to unattended.</u>
